##### Description of the land to which the designation applies

The Ministerial designation applies to land located at 111 Palmwoods-Montville Road, Palmwoods.

The site is located within the Sunshine Coast Regional Council local government area and consists of three allotments described as:

- Lot 792 on CG809507;
- Lot 5 on RP135106; and
- Lot 6 on RP135106.

##### Type of community infrastructure for which the land has been designated

The land has been designated for the Palmwoods State School. The community infrastructure is described under Schedule 2 of the *Sustainable Planning Regulation 2009* as follows:

- (e) community and cultural facilities, including child-care facilities, community centres, meeting halls, galleries and libraries; and
- (g) educational facilities;

Commencing from the intersection of the Warrego Hwy and Dawson Gates Rd, north along Dawson Gates Rd to Chinchilla-Wondai Rd, north along Chinchilla-Wondai Rd to Monmouth Bridge Road, then north to Dahlers Rd, then west along Dahlers Rd to Auburn Rd, and then in a general line from the intersection of Auburn Rd and Dahlers Rd, south west to the intersection of the Warrego Hwy and Rubbish Dump Rd. Then in a southerly line from Rubbish Dump Rd to the Chinchilla-Tara Rd, then in an easterly direction from the Chinchilla-Tara Rd, along the Condamine River, past the southern end of Windmill Rd, Wallers Rd and Rifle Range Rd, and then north to the Warrego Hwy, and then west to the intersection of the Warrego Hwy and Dawson Gates Rd.
