New Acland Stage 3: key submission issues: suggested solutions

1. Land impacts – 1,466 disturbance area
 - Within this: open-cut pits: 1,201ha.
 - final voids: 457ha
 - grazing land: temporary impacted: 54ha
 - cropping land: permanent impact: 1,185ha

2. Social Impacts

- requirement: demonstrate improved social licence, better engagement, consultation, survey, complaints

CG said: do more: have to do better'
 'improv' ment?
 conditions

proposal: condition regular reporting on engagement, particularly with landholders near mine and Jondaryan; online monthly environmental reporting (air, noise, vibration)

3. Jondaryan – decommissioning of rail load-out facility

- many concerns raised regarding uncertainty of facility being moved
- confusion about timeframes

proposal: condition new rail load-out facility to be sole distribution point for the project

4. Road closures

- road diversions alter current access, resulting in additional travel times of up to 30km
- associated emergency response time issues

proposal - spray seal some currently unsealed local roads (approx. 8km)

noise/air - real time monitoring (reporting on) sought

extra real-time monitoring
