### 5.1 Technical agency advice for SARA as assessment manager

Our agency:

(a) recommends refusal of all of the application for the reasons described below (*Planning Act 2016* section 60(2)(d) or 60(3)(c)):

### (i) The reasons for this decision are:

 The proposed development does not satisfy the State Development Assessment Provisions

### (A) Findings on material questions of fact:

- The applicant has stated on Page 6, Drawing 24635,D,504.0.1 and page 35 of the
  certified report that water that does not meet the acceptable quality for release is to be
  reused for irrigation practices and will be lifted out of the dams via 3 main pump sites (1
  per dam)
- PO16 states that works that contain CAR water must not increase the amount of overflow water taken and must allow for the release of water when an acceptable quality of water is achieved.
- The development does not satisfy PO16 as
  - the proposed irrigation may increase the take of overland flow in the plan area;
     and
  - water must be released once it is of an acceptable quality into the catchment as close as practicable to its flow path prior to construction of the works. If the water is not of acceptable quality then it should not be released.
- The applicant has not demonstrated that the construction and operation of the proposed works will not increase the average volume of surface water that may be taken within the plan area.

SARA would not give an operational works permit under s97 of the Water Act) as it would be considered as Accepted development under the Water Regulation therefore an approval is not required. DRDMW has confirmed that the proposed works is assessable (does not meet the requirements of s97).

The application that was submitted to SARA was properly made as assessable development. The application included DA Form 1 and Template 3 – Taking overland flow water. Template 3 question 4 and 7 notes what work the applicant has applied for.

I acknowledged that the applicant in response to various advice notices/Information requests have stated that they are exempt under s97 of the water act, however if this was the case SARA wouldn't be a referral agency or assessment manager under the Planning

Regarding your below email, the proposed applications are considered assessable development in accordance with schedule 9 of the Water Regulation 2016, due to the requirement under section 97 of the Water Act 2000 not being met.

## The statutory authorisation provided by section 97 (Environmental authorities)

Note, the statutory authorisation to take overland flow (OLF) water provided for by section 97 of the Water Act; **only applies** when an EA; or a DP for carrying out an environmentally relevant activity **explicitly requires** overland flow water to be captured and **only to the extent and not more than the volume** necessary to satisfy the requirements of the EA or DP.

The Water Plans do not specifically quote the requirement for capture and release, they reference that there must not be an increase in the amount of water taken. I have added to the table below the sections of the plans that reference that there must not be an increase and the limitations.

State Code 10: Taking or interfering with water details in the purpose statement item 5. that the QMDB allows for the capture of contaminated agricultural run-off water and release of water when an acceptable water quality it achieved. As part of our assessment under the Planning Act 2016 and Water Regulation 2016, the purpose of the state code along with performance outcome PO16 is used to ensure that no increase in take occurs.

Regarding your below email, the proposed applications are considered assessable development in accordance with schedule 9 of the Water Regulation 2016, due to the requirement under section 97 of the Water Act 2000 not being met.

# The statutory authorisation provided by section 97 (Environmental authorities)

Note, the statutory authorisation to take overland flow (OLF) water provided for by section 97 of the Water Act; <u>only applies</u> when an EA; or a DP for carrying out an environmentally relevant activity <u>explicitly requires</u> overland flow water to be captured and <u>only to the extent and not more than the volume</u> necessary to satisfy the requirements of the EA or DP.

The Water Plans do not specifically quote the requirement for capture and release, they reference that there must not be an increase in the amount of water taken. I have added to the table below the sections of the plans that reference that there must not be an increase and the limitations.

Hi Richard,

SARA would not give an operational works permit under s97 of the Water Act) as it would be considered as Accepted development under the Water Regulation therefore an approval is not required. DRDMW has confirmed that the proposed works is assessable (does not meet the requirements of s97).

The application that was submitted to SARA was properly made as assessable development. The application included DA Form 1 and Template 3 – Taking overland flow water. Template 3 question 4 and 7 notes what work the applicant has applied for.

I acknowledged that the applicant in response to various advice notices/Information requests have stated that they are exempt under s97 of the water act, however if this was the case SARA wouldn't be a referral agency or assessment manager under the Planning Regulation. The applicant has not made a formal change to the application or withdrawn it since the original forms were submitted. Our agency:

(a) recommends refusal of all of the application for the reasons described below (*Planning Act 2016* section 60(2)(d) or 60(3)(c)):

#### (i) The reasons for this decision are:

 The proposed development does not satisfy the State Development Assessment Provisions

#### (A) Findings on material questions of fact:

- The applicant has stated on Page 6, Drawing 24635,D,504.0.1 and page 35 of the
  certified report that water that does not meet the acceptable quality for release is to be
  reused for irrigation practices and will be lifted out of the dams via 3 main pump sites (1
  per dam)
- PO16 states that works that contain CAR water must not increase the amount of overflow water taken and must allow for the release of water when an acceptable quality of water is achieved.
- The development does not satisfy PO16 as
  - the proposed irrigation may increase the take of overland flow in the plan area;
     and
  - water must be released once it is of an acceptable quality into the catchment as close as practicable to its flow path prior to construction of the works. If the water is not of acceptable quality then it should not be released.
- The applicant has not demonstrated that the construction and operation of the proposed works will not increase the average volume of surface water that may be taken within the plan area.

Advice note to applicant

#### General advice

New works to capture contaminated agricultural runoff in the Queensland Murray-Darling Basin must operate under store and release arrangements which involves storing contaminated water, monitoring the water quality, then releasing the water to the environment when it no longer poses a contamination risk. The re-use of any stored contaminated agricultural runoff water is not permitted.

The Queensland Government is seeking to manage and better account for the take of overland flow water in the Condamine and Balonne, and Border Rivers and Moonie catchments.

Provisions are in force for landowners who take contaminated agricultural runoff. **Under these provisions**, you must make a record every time you:


- · take overland flow water that is contaminated agricultural runoff, or
- carry out an agricultural activity that may contaminate overland flow water resulting in it needing to be captured on-farm.


The records should include:


- the volume of contaminated agricultural runoff taken
- when the contaminated agricultural runoff was taken
- the nature of the event
- the source and purpose of the contaminant
- how the contaminant was applied
- the extent to which the application was consistent with best practice, standards, codes and product labels.


Records may be made in hard copy or electronically and must be kept for five years. The Queensland Government may request to inspect these records at any time. It is an offence to not produce the records for inspection when requested.

# Good afternoon Rebecca.

Regarding your below email, the proposed applications are considered assessable development in accordance with schedule 9 of the Water Regulation 2016, due to the requirement under section 97 of the Water Act 2000 not being met.

# The statutory authorisation provided by section 97 (Environmental authorities)

Note, the statutory authorisation to take overland flow (OLF) water provided for by section 97 of the Water Act; **only applies** when an EA; or a DP for carrying out an environmentally relevant activity **explicitly requires** overland flow water to be captured and **only to the extent and not more than the volume** necessary to satisfy the requirements of the EA or DP.

The Water Plans do not specifically quote the requirement for capture and release, they reference that there must not be an increase in the amount of water taken. I have added to the table below the sections of the plans that reference that there must not be an increase and the limitations.

State Code 10: Taking or interfering with water details in the purpose statement item 5. that the QMDB allows for the capture of contaminated agricultural run-off water and release of water when an acceptable water quality it achieved. As part of our assessment under the Planning Act 2016 and Water Regulation 2016, the purpose of the state code along with performance outcome PO16 is used to ensure that no increase in take occurs.
