DECLARATION OF LUXURY MOTOR VEHICLE (no. 01) 2008

Short title

 This notice may be cited as the Declaration of Luxury Motor Vehicle (No. 01) 2008

Commencement

2. This notice shall commence at 15 February 2008.

Definitions

3. In this notice:

"luxury motor vehicle" means a vehicle declared by the chief executive under Section 145 to be a luxury motor vehicle.

"limousine service" means an unscheduled public passenger service provided by a luxury motor vehicle where the fare is decided before the journey begins.

Declaration of particular motor vehicles [s.145 of the Act]

- 4. The chief executive may, by gazette notice, declare a vehicle to be a luxury motor vehicle. This authority is delegated to the Executive Director, Passenger Transport Division.
- 5. By that authority the following vehicles are approved as Group D luxury motor vehicles under Schedule 4 of the Transport Operations (Passenger Transport) Regulation 2005. The maximum age limit for these vehicles will be 12 years from the date of manufacture.
 - 5.1 Ford Territory, stretched to provide more than nine seating positions, including the driver's position
 - 5.2 Hummer H3, stretched to provide more than nine seating positions, including the driver's position
