

**Notice of Ministerial designation of land
for community infrastructure
under the *Integrated Planning Act 1997***

A Ministerial designation has been made

I, ROD WELFORD MP, Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts, give notice that under the *Integrated Planning Act 1997*, chapter 2, part 6, I made a Ministerial designation of land for community infrastructure.

Description of the land to which the designation applies

The Ministerial designation applies to land located at Ormeau. The land is described as Lots 1 and 3 on SP 196447.

Type of proposed community infrastructure for which the land has been designated

The land has been designated for a Year 8 to Year 12 state high school and includes community, cultural, sporting facilities and associated infrastructure and associated road, vehicle lay-bys and car-parking facilities servicing the proposed school.

This community infrastructure is described under the *Integrated Planning Act 1997*, schedule 5 as:

- (d) community and cultural facilities, including child-care facilities, community centres, meeting halls, galleries and libraries;
- (f) educational facilities;
- (l) parks and recreational facilities;
- (o) transport infrastructure mentioned in s.5.1.1; and
- (r) storage and works depots and the like including administrative facilities associated with the provision or maintenance of the community infrastructure mentioned in paragraphs (d), (f), (l) and (o) above.
