


• As the Queensland Government's builder, QBuild partners with government agencies to plan, build, maintain and respond on government-owned facilities across the state.



Plan, Build, Maintain, Respond

- Plan: Planning for infrastructure and individual asset needs, for input into feasibility options, needs analysis and business case requirements – all in support of government investment.
- Build: the construction of new buildings, and upgrades and improvements to existing buildings to increase their useful life.
- Maintain: work on existing buildings to reinstate their physical condition or prevent deterioration and failure.
- Respond: rapid response to disaster events or hazard incidents which pose a risk to Queenslanders as users or occupiers of state government facilities.

QBuild Registration

- To be engaged to provide services to government through QBuild you need to register with QBuild.
- You can do this online via –
 https://www.business.qld.gov.au/industries/building-property-development/building-construction/supply-queensland-government/minor-works-maintenance
- You will need to provide information including ABN or ACN, Certificates of Currency for insurances, trade licences for the work you do, WH&S compliance.
- If you have already registered and need to update your details, you can do this online as well.

- When you register with QBuild, you will receive notifications on:
 - Current opportunities
 - Licencing or legislative changes
 - Work Health and Safety Alerts
- QBuild is now also providing the opportunity for suppliers that are not registered to receive these alerts. You can do this by going here – QBuild Mailing List
- This will enable you to be included in any industry communications even without being registered
- To participate in tendering opportunities, you will still need to register with QBuild

Tendering Methods and Systems

IRIS Tenders

Goods or Works/Services up to \$250,000 (GST Inclusive). Not publicly advertised. Select Tender process for QBuild registered contractors/suppliers only (via Regional/District QBuild office). These opportunities are price only with no requirement for non-price submissions. You will receive any requests for price via email and they are to be responded via email.

QBuild e-Tender

Construction works over \$250,000 (GST Inclusive). Tenders for construction (and demolition), fitout and maintenance projects, including those relating to public education, health and sports facilities. Select or Open Tender process. You will login to the system to download and submit tender applications

Vendor Panel

• All public tenders are advertised via this system with information about the location of the tender documents and tender close location.

Prequalification (PQC) System

- For work on major government building projects, there is a requirement to be prequalified through the prequalification system (PQC) for:
- A contractor who wants to tender for building projects valued at more than \$1 Million (GST inclusive)
- A building consultant who wants to be considered for commissions over \$60,000 (GST inclusive) or where the PQC service risk rating is 3 or 4.

Social Procurement

Non-Price Criteria

- Non-Price Criteria (NPC) is a requirement to provide QBuild with information about your experience, methodology relating to the project. The tender documents will provide descriptions of what you are to submit and this can include:
 - Relevant experience in delivering similar projects
 - Your methodology for project delivery
 - Your workplace health and safety practices
 - How you meet local benefit requirements
