

#### Mackay Regional Council at a glance

- > 1195 staff
- ➤ Services provided to approximately 125,000 people (50,000 rateable properties) across 7,600 square kilometres
- > Services provided include:
  - ➤ Community Facilities
  - > Parks and Environment
  - ➤ Water and Waste Services
  - Transport, Drainage and Flood Risk mitigation
- ➤ Infrastructure portfolio approx. \$6B (replacement cost)
- ➤ Annual Budget for 25/26 \$454M




#### CAPITAL WORKS PROGRAM \$125.6M

















### **Investment by locality**

#### **Northern Beaches Community Hub**

#### Stage 1A


- \$11M
- Opened July 2025
- Undercover multi-purpose court, adjoining kitchen, nature play and picnic spaces, as well as landscaping, pedestrian links and a parking area

#### Stage 1B

- \$43M
- Construction commenced. Due for completion in early 2027.
- Includes library, community meeting rooms, café











# Resource Centre of Excellence Stage 2: Future Industries Hub

- \$12.2M
- Focus on incubating new industries, including a pilot processing plant to support activities around critical minerals, reprocessing of tailings and other precious metals.
- The building construction is nearing completion with fit-out of Critical Minerals Research Plant (Tenancy 1) to start in near future









#### **Finch Hatton MTB**

- Future Stages currently in design development
- Cost Estimate \$30M delivery of future stages subject to funding
- Stage 1 gaining positive feedback, current numbers since opening from trail counter – 28,850 trail rides














## Northern Beaches Traffic Improvements

Significant investment in transport infrastructure in the Northern Beaches to help ease congestion and allow for continued growth in the Northern Beaches.

#### Projects include:

- Reed St / Norwood Parade Extension \$11M scheduled to commence construction within coming months
- Wallmans Road widening and upgrade \$9M scheduled to commence construction 2027
- Dawson Boulevard \$12M (TBC design underway) scheduled to commence construction 2027
- Glenella-Richmond/Holts Road roundabout \$8M scheduled to commence construction 2026





## Pioneer River Flood Mitigation Project

- Project estimate \$18M
- Design and approvals complete
- Out to Tender in coming months with intent to commence construction by early 2026
- Completion scheduled 2026 / 2027






