

# Smart Water Meters

- \$24 million program replacing existing mechanical water meters with smart water meters throughout the Cairns region to improve the community's water network and achieve overall water savings
- Total of 8,600+ SWM meters installed with stable communication of water usage with installation rates set to increase by mid-2024

#### SUSTAINABILITY INITIATIVES

#### **Recycled Glass Aggregate**

Cairns Regional Council is repurposing glass for civil construction, a process that is well underway and has received support from Department of Transport, Main Roads and FNQROC.

Recycled glass aggregate is manufactured locally in the Cairns Glass Processing Facility from recycled glass food and beverage bottles and containers collected though kerbside recycling bins and the container refund scheme. Each year the facility processes over 9,000 tonnes of glass into recycled glass aggregate – the equivalent of recycling around 45 million glass bottles.





#### GET READY FOR LOW CARBON PROCUREMENT

#### Our low carbon procurement transition involves:

- Requesting information from prospective suppliers about their practices and capability.
- Improving emissions and activity data for priority goods and services (e.g. improved tracking, quantifying materials & fuels usage).
- Encouraging emissions reduction initiatives in its contracts and projects.










Showing the observed river height against flood thresholds. Latest data as of 2PM 18 December 2023.




