The MID includes requirements in relation to the location and scale of the development, stormwater management, flood management, car parking, bicycle parking, public transport, workplace travel plan, waste collection, external works, bushfire management, ecology, acoustics, design/built form, landscaping, lighting, helipad and operational airspace, refuse plant and screening, temporary worker's accommodation, construction management, information signage, geotechnical conditions, acid sulfate soils and public utility services.
