## AP2023/009 – SDA application for a material change of use (MCU) for a medium impact industry (plastic manufacturing) and warehouse in the Townsville State Development Area (SDA)

Milford Planning has submitted an SDA application for a MCU for a medium impact industry (plastic manufacturing) and warehouse in the Townsville SDA. The Coordinator-General has nominated Townsville City Council as a referral entity given its interests, which may impact on, or be impacted by, this SDA application, and in accordance with Schedule 2, Section 2.2 of the Townsville SDA Development Scheme (May 2019).

- a referral entity submission by 23 August 2023. Submissions should contain recommendations to address the impact of the proposed development (including recommended conditions). Referral entity submissions may be forwarded to the proponent for consideration and response.

If Townsville City Council does not respond within the referral entity response period, the Coordinator-General may proceed to the next stage of the assessment process as if the SDA application was assessed and Townsville City Council had no requirements.
