 - Goals
 - Growth opportunities
 - Actions
- Project funding will be assessed by how well they align to the relevant road map, including growth opportunities and goals.

Modern Manufacturing Initiative

Grants: **\$1m to \$20m** in matched funding
Competitive, merit-based grants program

Translation: to help translate

good ideas into commercial outcomes

- Validate later stage commercialisation activities
- Bring commercial outcomes to new and existing markets and customers
- Embrace new technologies and pivot into higher value activities

Integration: to help firms

integrate into domestic and global value chains

- Encourage manufacturers to adopt new technologies to support entry into new markets
- Support manufacturers to overcome barriers that are preventing them from identifying and accessing new value chains

Assessment Process

Assessment criterion 1

Project alignment with:

- Objectives of stream
- Priority Road Map
- Growth of manufacturing sector

50 points

Assessment criterion 2

Capacity, capability and resources to deliver the project

- Track record
- Project plan
- Access to approvals, finance, IP, infrastructure

30 points

Assessment criterion 3

Impact of the grant funding on your project

- Partnerships leveraged
- Expanded outcomes in terms of scale, timing and business impact

20 points
