Thank you both for your time this afternoon and for providing the attached information regarding Ark Energy's proposal.

As we discussed, based on the small scale of the intensification, and the expected vehicle size being limited to refuse collection and buses or similar, TMR does not have any objections to the proposed amendment to Condition 7 of AP2021/004.

Should the proposed amendment change in future, the volume of traffic associated with the amendment intensify, or the vehicle size increase, please don't advise TMR so that we can determine that the above advice remains current.
