
Limited invitation Queensland and Australia events

SAN DIEGO ARRIVAL

Please find below some indicative information that may help you when you first get to San Diego.

Transport

Taxicab stands are located at the airport, many hotels, attractions, and shopping centres. Base fare and rates are displayed on the meter and include a flag drop charge plus a per-mile and/or a per-hour charge. If you are travelling from the airport, they will also add \$2.00 to your final total. Lyft and Uber are also well-established in San Diego and can service San Diego's airport.

San Diego shuttle services are a convenient way to navigate the city and are ideal for airport pick-ups and dropoffs, as well as going to and from the convention centre and cruise ship terminal. There are also local shuttle companies that offer sightseeing tours, daily excursions, and transportation for weddings and private parties.

Public transport - Pronto Fare System

There's a whole new way to get everywhere you need to go around the San Diego region: The PRONTO card and app. PRONTO (which replaces the old Compass Card system) lets you get a move on faster and easier anytime you want to ride the San Diego Trolley, a bus or the Coaster train. The cloud-based system allows users to add funds instantly, and then buy a ticket when needed with a simple tap of the card or phone at a station kiosk.

One-way fares are valid for unlimited transfers within two hours of activation, and PRONTO also lets you earn as you go toward a day or month pass on the Trolley or buses. Download the PRONTO app at the Apple or Google Play stores, or pick up a card at retail outlets, the MTS Transit Store (at 12th and Imperial avenues), NCTD customer service centres or ticket vending machines. 
We hope that your BIO2024 experience will be a success.
