



4.3 Guiding principles - Occupational health and safety

Scope

These guiding principles assist Special Purpose Vehicles (SPV) to develop occupational health and safety (OH&S) policies. These principles support the OH&S planning template, which is provided in 4_4_T Occupational Health and Safety Plan.

It is a minimum expectation that the SPV provides a safe and healthy work environment for all employees, contractors, clients and visitors.

Overarching principles

An SPV should have OH&S practices that are compliant with all relevant workplace health and safety legislation, codes of practice, Australian standards and site safety plans.

The SPV's OH&S practices should include:

- · use of qualified OH&S staff, where necessary
- · providing information and training
- all operations comply with relevant OH&S legislation
- the use of safe equipment
- · continuous improvement in any safety management systems
- support and assistance to injured employees and contractors
- any intra project OH&S.
