Development scheme review

EDQ has commenced a review of the PDA development scheme, to ensure it continues to operate effectively as a plan making and development assessment tool.

The scope of review will look at:

- land use and infrastructure planning, to ensure the vision for the PDA is contemporary and appropriate
- assessment criteria included in the development scheme which guides new development.

The review is likely to result in amendments to the PDA development scheme following consultation with the community and other stakeholders.



PROJECT STAGES:

MARCH - JUNE 2016*

Stage 1: Information review

EDQ gathers and reviews planning, infrastructure, property market, stakeholder and community information.

JUNE - AUGUST 2016*

Stage 2: Planning options analysis

EDQ will examine planning options and concepts for the PDA based on information gathered in stage 1.

AUGUST - OCTOBER 2016*

Stage 3: Draft amendments and public notification

EDQ will prepare draft development scheme amendments and publicly notify them so interested parties can make submissions.

OCTOBER - DECEMBER 2016*

Stage 4: Adoption of development scheme amendments

EDQ will review and consider all submissions, prepare a submission review report and produce a final amended development scheme for state government approval.
